

Mass Audubon Wellfleet Bay Wildlife Sanctuary Service Dogs and our Campground

Service dogs, including those for emotional comfort and support, are welcome at Mass Audubon. Our wildlife sanctuary provides habitat for wildlife, and they can perceive even well-trained service animals as predators. For the safety and comfort of wildlife, and to provide safe and comfortable experiences for all of our visitors, we ask service dog handlers to please:

- Keep service dogs on a 6-foot leash at all times.
- Service dogs are not allowed to roam freely (off leash) around the campgrounds or at campsites.
- Please always pick up after your dog and dispose of poop bags/trash in the proper receptacle.
- Dogs cannot be left unattended at the campsite or in your vehicle.
- Service dogs are welcome on the nature trails with the person they support. Other family members may leash walk service dogs for exercise and potty breaks within the campground area. The towns of Eastham and Wellfleet have areas which allow free running exercise for dogs.
- Service dogs must be indicated on the campground reservation at the time of reservation.
- Service dogs must be up to date on all vaccinations. A copy of an up-to-date rabies certificate must be provided at check-in.
